Instructions

AIR POLLUTION DETECTIVES

1. Keep count in your Science Journal of how many things you shut off every day, and how many times (lights, computer, phone, etc.)
2. Bring the total to school each day for a week.
3. Tally the numbers every day and record them on the graph.
4. Answer the following questions:
 - a. What kinds of things did you shut off during the week?
 - b. How many times did you shut each thing off?
 - c. Why do you think it is important to be aware of turning or shutting things that use electricity off?
